

The Numeracy and Literacy catch up funding for the year 2017/2018 will not be allocated to the school until February 2018. However due to the success of the previous year's funding we can allocate funds as follows based on a projected funding figure of £12000.

| Intervention | Cost | Potential Impact |

| Reading/SPAG/ CATS, Tests for all Year 7 students | £1,800 CATS | Identify specific weaknesses or strengths in spelling and academic excellence. Also to assess pupils in Verbal, Quantitative and Non-verbal reasoning. |
| Fresh Start – Intervention sessions | £700 | Increased confidence in students' abilities to read age-related texts, and low-attaining readers to meet expected level for secondary school. |
| Numeracy interventions sessions | £1500 | Small group sessions run both in lesson time and registration to focus on particular skills of basic numeracy and times tables |
| Literacy intervention sessions | £3000 | Allow students the opportunity to develop Literacy skills, in small groups, that is vital for progression across all subjects |
| TLR for Literacy Coordinator | £2640 | Strategic leadership for the rapid progress of students not at the expected levels in reading from Year 7. |
| Spelling and Reading Tests | £500 | Regular assessment of the weakest students to check progress with spelling and reading |
| HLTA and Teachers to support across English Lessons | £2000 | A greater number of teaching assistants and support staff to support progress in English Lessons |
| Brain Gym | £500 | Acquire new strategies to help improve performance overall, with 26 specific Brain Gym movements that will improve thinking, movement, learning and literacy for all. |
| Buddy Reader System | £400 | Teaching/training of older students to support younger students with their reading during form time. |
